## Eligible H.S. Seniors – Apply for [ACEC Oregon Scholarship](#)

**ELIGIBILITY/REQUIREMENTS:**

- Must be either a graduating high school senior (including GED students and home-schooled seniors) or have had no previous college education.
- GPA: 3.30+
- SAT score: 1800+ combined SAT scores or ACT composite of 28+
- Major: Civil, electrical, environmental or mechanical engineering
- Career field (preference): Applicants interested in the consulting engineering profession
- Colleges: Any Oregon four-year college that offers Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology accredited programs in the major fields of study (currently OIT, OSU, PSU, George Fox, University of Portland; check with your college if unsure of its accreditation)
- FAFSA: Not required - not based on financial need
- Automatically renewable if criteria met

**IMPORTANT DEADLINES**

- **February 16, 2016 - 5:00 P.M. PST: Early Bird deadline.** Complete applications (including transcripts) submitted by this date and time receive an early review, and **error-free apps will be entered into a drawing for one of several \$1,000 Early Bird scholarship awards.**
- **March 1 - 5:00 P.M. PST each year:** Final deadline for all materials to be submitted to OSAC.
