[Adapting Water Supplies Post-Condit Dam Removal](#)

The 2011 decommissioning and removal of the Condit Hydroelectric Dam—one of the biggest dam removal projects in US history— provided new opportunities for the City of White Salmon to secure additional water supplies while improving instream flows in Buck Creek and the White Salmon River. Aspect Consulting's president and principal hydrogeologist [Tim Flynn](#) has been working with the City for over a decade to resolve water supply issues. In his presentation Tim will discuss the short-term use of the Condit Dam water rights for stream restoration; establishment of mitigation banks associated with Condit Dam water rights for the City and Klickitat County to offset future out-of-stream demands; ongoing development of source alternatives to reduce demand on Buck Creek and improve habitat; and use of ASR to capture seasonally available flows from Buck Creek and reduce surface water diversions during critical low flow periods.
