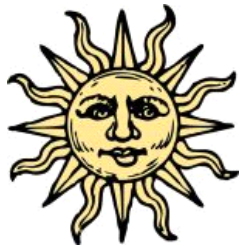

Coba’s Capitol Comments

Next Wednesday the May quarterly revenue estimate for the state will be released in Salem. This will be the final major data drop to develop agency budgets and will be the catalyst to bring closure to an incredibly odd and different legislative session.

This week in the Joint Transportation Committee, **HB 3065 -8** amendments had a hearing. These amendments are sponsored by Speaker of the House **Tina Kotek** and deal with the major projects from the 2017 session, tolling implementation, and other key issues. Several environmental organizations opposed the amendments and their

perceived commitment to expanding highways in the metro region over transit of light rail.

HB 3065-8 amendments will replace the original bill if they are adopted. Click on the link below to view the proposed amendments:
