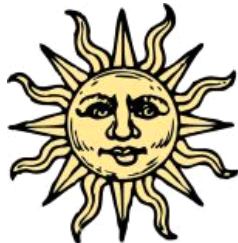

Coba’s Capitol Comments

The second major deadline passed last Friday as bills needed to be out of the policy committee in the second chamber. With this deadline, a number of policy committees will be closed for the session. However, key committees including Ways and Means, Rules, Judiciary, Revenue and Joint Transportation will remain open until sine die.

The May revenue forecast will be released this afternoon with additional revenue anticipated to be the good news that legislators will receive. This revenue forecast will be the last forecast for budget leaders as they finish work on the 2021-23 budget.

The Joint Transportation Committee continues to meet and will hold a work session next Tuesday, May 25 on **HB 3055** -14 amendments and **HB 3065** -8 amendments supported by Speaker Kotek.
