ACEC Oregon lobbyist **Marshall Coba** will discuss the upcoming legislative session.

After more than 2,000 miles and twelve hearings, we are pleased two key members of the Joint Committee on Transportation Modernization and Preservation Committee will also join Coba.

Sen. Brian Boquist, R-Dallas, is co-Vice Chair and the leading republican in the Senate on transportation. **Rep. John Lively**, D-Springfield, is a longtime supporter of transportation including during his service as Mayor of Springfield.

Both legislators bring an unique perspective and will share their vision for what and how a package should be developed. Will the rural-urban split be bridged this session? Will Rs and Ds work across the aisle and across the Capitol to get it done?

ACEC priorities for the 2017 legislative session include:

- Developing and passing a major transportation funding package prior to adjournment of the '17 session.
- Continued support for implementation of a statewide resiliency plan for seismic and tsunami preparedness and recovery.
- Bonding for seismic upgrades to schools and essential buildings.
